

Kent Auto Developments Instructions for Fitting Steering Rack Stops

With car on axle stands and wheels removed, carefully pull back the steering rack gaiters each side to expose the steering rack itself. The rack stops fit over the end of the pivot joint on the end of the rack and limit the full lock position of the steering rack at either side.

The steering rack stops are made for the most common rack fitted to the Mini and must be a snug fit on the rack, secured in place with the cable ties provided. Under no circumstances should the rack stops be loose on the rack and be able to slide onto the rack itself, as this could lock the steering into a dead ahead position with disastrous results! If this could be the case, it would be better not to fit them at all.

Once fitted, check that it is not possible for the calipers to touch the suspension tie rods, and replace the gaiters, fastening with lock wire or cable ties.
